



Clinical Manager – Social Worker Bowdoin Street Health Center

Bowdoin Street Health Center seeks a Clinical Manager of Social Work to join our expanding behavioral health and community health worker teams. The Clinical Manager works with interdisciplinary leadership to define and oversee best practice standards. Monitors the quality of social work staff performance and productivity in accordance with established standards. Identifies opportunities for quality improvement and works with other managers to plan and implement departmental quality improvement initiatives. Collaborates closely with medical, nursing, and administrative leaders to align and integrate social work practice with overall practice and strategic goals. Advocates for patients and the health center around the state, federal, and managed care policy changes. Responsible for the professional development of social work and interdisciplinary staff. Develops educational programs for social work staff, graduate students, medical students, nurses, and trainees of other health care disciplines.

The Clinical Manager will also provide direct clinical services to clients, oversee and manage the intake, case disposition, and assignment processes, and provide clinical and administrative supervision to clinicians and community health workers.

The Bowdoin Street Health Center is a multi-specialty practice serving the Bowdoin-Geneva community of Boston. We provide comprehensive primary care, behavioral health services, and several specialty care services. Our behavioral health department is highly collaborative and is very committed to meeting patient needs. In addition, the behavioral health department is fully integrated within the health center as a whole and there is ample opportunity for close collaboration with the primary care providers.
